Dr. Chavasse is responsible for PSI's malaria control programs in 32 countries in Africa, Asia and Latin America. These programs focus on delivering insecticide-treated mosquito nets at scale through public, private and integrated campaign channels and increasing access to effective malaria treatment by delivering and promoting prepackaged ACT through private sector and community-based channels. Dr. Chavasse is also the Project Director of *ACTwatch*, which monitors the availability, price, volume and use of antimalarials in seven countries. Dr. Chavasse has a PhD in Medical Entomology from the Liverpool School of Tropical Medicine, was a researcher/lecturer at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine for eight years and has over 20 years experience in the control of vector borne diseases with a principal focus on malaria.
